Aged 23 Son of Mr & Mrs Albert Cockerill of Ivy Cottages Green End

Remembered with Honour Bay 5 Arras Memorial

Private Godfrey Bousefield Harrison 17780 - 6th Battalion Yorkshire Regiment Died 29 September 1915

Aged 38 Son of Mr & Mrs Watson Harrison, Husband of Ada Ethel Harrison of Mallyan Lodge (Hotel) – First Landlord of Mallyan Hotel Goathland

Interred Alexandria (Chatby) Military Cemetery

Private Edwin Pennock 33023 10th Battalion Yorkshire Regiment Died October 1917

Aged 31 Son of Mr & Mrs Nesswell Pennock of Lins Farm Beckhole

Interred A.I.F Burial Ground Fleurs

Private Arthur Rymer 45740 6th Battalion Yorkshire Regiment Died 9th October 1917

Aged 20 Son of Mr & Mrs James Rymer of Prudom House Goathland

Private John Ward 19295 10th Battalion Yorkshire Regiment Died 30th April 1916

Aged 20 Son of Elizabeth Ward (Widower) of Hawthorn Hill Farm Beckhole

Lance Corporal John Yeoman Light 471423 222nd Field Company Royal Engineers Died 14th April 1918

Aged 31 Husband of Edith Light nee Richardson of Waites House Goathland

Private George Pybus 13th Battalion Duke of Wellingtons West Riding Regiment Died 29th September 1918

Aged 18 Son of Mr & Mrs John Pybus of Hollin Garth Farm Green End

Remembered with Honour New Military Cemetery Lacouture.

2nd Lieutenant George Smailes 2nd Battalion Price of Wales Own West Riding Regiment Died 2nd October 1916

Aged 22 Son of Captain & Mrs Richard Smailes of Fairhaven Goathland

Remembered with Honour Thiepval Memorial

Apprentice Robert Sleightholme S.S Dunrobin Mercantile Marine Died 24th November 1917

Aged 18 Son of Mr & Mrs James Sleightholme of Rose Cottage Goathland

Remembered with Honour Tower Hill Memorial & the Memorial Hymn Board St.Marys Church Goathland

Private Sydney Whiteley 2710 Yorkshire Regiment Died 11th November 1919

Aged 22 Son of Mr & Mrs William Whiteley of Facey Hall Green End (Now demolished it stood behind the former Hunt Kennels)

Remembered with Honour St.Marys Churchyard Birdsall

Corporal Edwin Widdowson 19422 21st Battalion Kings Own Royal Regiment Died of War Wounds 25th January 1918

Aged 39 Son of Jane Widdowson (Widower) of Hillcrest Mill Green Way Goathland

Thomas John Readman Civilian Railway Company France A Section No 4 Coy Died 2nd April 1917

Aged 40 Husband of Hannah Mary Readman of No2 Incline Cottages Goathland
